



RECITAL FAQ'S:

HOW LONG DOES IT LAST?:

Each performer performs in one 50 minute set. Sets are on the hour (2-2:50, 3-3:50, etc). It is designed so that you can leave after that set. *Please do not leave during the 50 minute set. As a courtesy to all of the performers, please watch the entire 50 minute program as we want every student to have the same amount of respect from the audience.

WHERE IS IT?:

The recital will be held at San Diego State University in San Diego. The address is [Aztec Bowl, San Diego, CA 92182 \(SDSU Parking Structure 12\)](#).

PARKING:

Please plan to park in Parking Structure 12, which is the closest structure to the venue. Parking is \$11 per vehicle and must be paid electronically (no cash accepted). You can pay either:

- At one of the parking kiosks located in the structure
- Through the PayByPhone app on your mobile device

You will need to enter your license plate number when completing your payment. After parking and paying, please make your way to the top level of the parking structure, where signage and Academy staff will help guide you to the venue entrance. There is plenty of parking available, including handicap-accessible parking.

WHAT DO THE PERFORMERS WEAR?:

Black pants or skirts with a white button-up shirt or top is traditional recital attire, but not required. Students should dress nicely for the occasion. Suits or formal dresses are also welcome—just ensure the student is comfortable performing.

WHAT DO WE BRING?

1. Your sheet music if you use it. 2. Your violin, guitar, bass, uke, etc.. We will provide amps and cables for you. 3. Drummers, bring your sticks. 4. Vocalists and pianists only need to bring their music and/or lyrics if needed.
